Kigali

Day 1

Volcanoes National Park

After breakfast, your day starts with a city tour. The craft market, Gisozi genocide memorial site & Kigali Museum are some of the attractions.

A 2 hours' drive to Ruhengeri area the second largest town in Rwanda, with its stunning backdrop of five volcanic mountains – The Virungas.

Arrive at Red rocks Intercultural Exchange centre for lunch then join the local brew makers to understand the process of brewing a local beer from bananas.

Later drive to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 2

Volcanoes National Park

After an early breakfast, you will proceed to the National Park headquarters – Kinigi to meet your guides for the day.

After completing our park formalities, we shall embark on a once in a lifetime experience of tracking mountain gorillas. Once you spot them you are allowed to spend an hour watching these amazing giant primates in their natural habitat. Return to your hotel for lunch and later dinner and overnight.

Volcanoes National Park & Rugezi Marsh

Rwanda has approximately 700 bird species. After early breakfast, we go to Volcanoes national park for the Ngezi walking trail with 45% of birding species found here.

Return to the lodge for Lunch. After lunch we shall depart for a 2 hrs drive to Kigali arriving there in the afternoon. Engage in last-minute shopping in one of the friendliest African capitals, before heading to the hotel for overnight.

Day 6

Drive from Arusha to Tarangire National Park where herds of up to 300 elephants scratch the dry riverbed for underground streams. Tarangire boasts over 500 bird species and features large numbers of game, particularly during the dry season. It rivals the Serengeti in its great number and diversity of wildlife. The landscape is of particular interest too, due to the high number of scenic baobab trees.

Lake Manyara National Park

Day 7

Today we head for Lake Manyara National Park. Here you will see the Great Rift Valley at its most impressive. Established to protect the vast elephant herds that the area is known for, Manyara features an incredible wealth of habitats, from soaring groundwater forest to Acacia woodland, a tranquil Flamingo-rimmed soda lake and bubbling hot springs. Lake Manyara's thick forests are a unique and surprising habitat for lion, known to climb and lounge in the trees. The endangered African wild dog and troops of several hundred olive baboon. Some 400 species of birds have been recorded here.

Ngorongoro Crater

Day 8

With breath taking views, The Ngorongoro Crater is home to some 25,000 large mammals, mainly ungulates, along with the highest density of mammalian predators in Africa. Black rhino are protected within the crater rim, giant tusked elephant wander the forests, black-maned lion stalk the grasslands and flamingos crowd the soda lakes. Towering euphorbia cling to the crater walls, fever and fig tree forests carpet the crater floor, while resplendent in their beads and furred in scarlet Shuka robes the Maasai tend their herds.

Central Serengeti

Day 9

Drive from Ngorongoro through Seronera to Serengeti National Park. Stretching along a vast plateau between the eastern arm of the rugged Rift Valley and the huge expanse of Lake Victoria. Famous for its vast, open grasslands and abundant wildlife. Perhaps best known as the site of the annual Great Migration, when an estimated three million antelope – mostly wildebeest — migrate to Kenya's Masai Mara Game Reserve to the North.

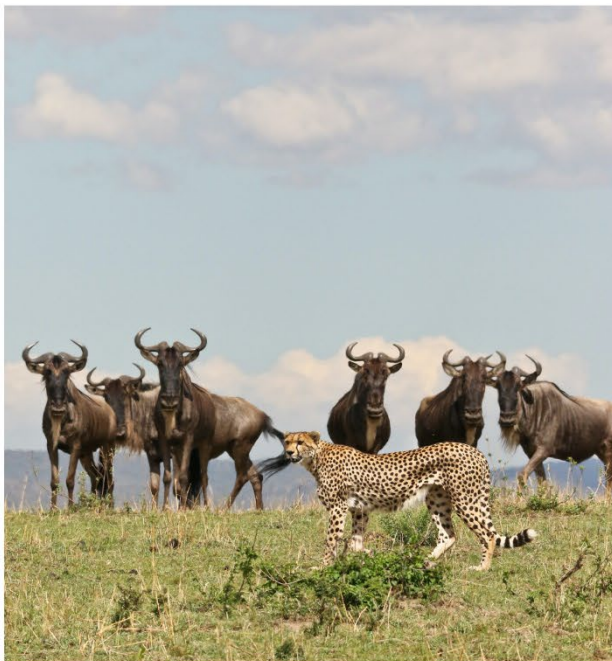

Northern Serengeti

Day 10

Between January and March, the wildebeest give birth on the short grass plains of the South-Eastern Serengeti. Attracting a vast plethora of predators, from lion to hyena, leopard, and cheetah. As the grazing runs low in this area the wildebeest move to the central Serengeti and then the Western Corridor before crossing the Grumeti and Mara Rivers on their journey to the Massai Mara in Kenya. Full day game drive. You will have time to explore the park, - morning and afternoon game drive.
